Feedback is collected periodically at the end of each session in order to assess the aspects that needs improvements. The various feedback parameters include the curriculum that is taught, teaching-learning, teaching aids, safety in the college campus, subject knowledge, etc and suggestions and opinions are taken at the end of each feedback. The recorded feedbacks are then presented in such a way that it is easily interpreted and understood. It is processed and analysed to obtain the feedback report. The data is presented in the IQAC committee for discussions and debates. This equips the teachers with information that can be used for quality enhancement and improve teaching outcome. The feedback system helps in the overall improvement of the college by identifying the areas that requires more effort to be put in to achieve excellence.

Academic Year 2022-23

Students Feedback Report and Action Taken Report

Students' feedback was collected from 380 students for the year 2022-23. There is a total of 11 questions with 5 grading options and the last question is on expression of opinions and suggestions for further improvement. The Feedback Report has been submitted to the IQAC and Academic Council for necessary action.

The feedback report is summarized as under:

1. For the parameter on syllabus coverage, 89.7% of the students have graded as excellent. 8.58% as very good, 0.52 % as good, none have graded as average and below average.
2. For the parameter on regularity of classes, 91.00 % have graded as excellent, 7.54% as very good, 0.26% as good, none have graded as average and below average.
3. For the parameter on punctuality of teachers in the class, 87.1% have graded as excellent, 11.18% as very good, 0.26% as good, 0.26% as average and none have graded as below average.
4. For the parameter on communication skill of the teachers, 86.06 % have graded as excellent, 12.22 % as very good, 0.52% as good and none has graded as average and below average.
5. For the parameter on the use of teaching aids, 87.36% have graded as excellent, 9.88% as very good, 1.3% as good, 0.26% as average and none have graded as below average.
6. For the parameter on availability of the teachers beyond normal classes, 90.74% have graded as excellent, 7.28% as very good, 0.78% as average and none have graded as below average.
7. For the parameter on pace of contents covered, 86.06% have graded as excellent, 9.88% as very good, 0.26% as good and none have graded as average and below average.

8. For the parameter on the helping attitude of the teachers towards the students, 91.52% have graded as excellent, 7.02% as very good, 0.26% as good and none have graded as average and below average.

9. For the parameter on contents of the syllabus, 92.3% have graded as excellent, 6.24% as very good, 0.26% as good and none have graded as average and below average

10. For the parameter on laboratory facilities, responses have not been given due to covid.

11. For the parameter on the overall effectiveness, 91.78% have graded as excellent, 6.24% as very good, 0.78% as good and none have graded as average and below average.

12. The students have expressed the need for filling the vacancies of teaching faculty in the various departments, to provide more text-books/reference books in the departments.

The collected feedback from the students have been satisfactory, however, the IQAC and the Academic Council has discussed the issues and concerns raised by the students. Accordingly, action have been taken regarding filling of vacant posts of teaching faculty by giving recommendations to the concerned authority. Taking into consideration the changing needs of the students, departmental libraries have been upgraded by adding more books related to the curriculum provided by the University.
